



## Wheaton Lions Members Responsibility Agreement

The Wheaton Lions Club is an organization that thrives on the active involvement and participation of its members. Members have various financial and physical responsibilities. This agreement will outline the requirements of members and shall be signed by all members to ensure their full understanding of what is expected of every Wheaton Lions member.

Financial responsibilities include quarterly dues. Quarterly dues are assessed until a member formally resigns. Until a member notifies the club that they are no longer a member, these dues are assessed every quarter and go onto the Club's Account Receivables. If a member chooses to or must resign from the club, any outstanding dues are still owed and must be paid in full. Just because a member decides they no longer wish to be a member that does not absolve them from their financial commitment up to that point.

Candy Day collecting is a physical requirement of all members. Members are expected to spend 2 hours once a year collecting money at an assigned location on Lions Candy Day. If a member is unable to physically collect money for 2 hours, that physical requirement then becomes a financial one. Any member who does not collect on Candy Day for whatever reason will be assessed a dollar amount, currently \$100. That assessment is due immediately. All outstanding assessments are due to Lions Charities even if a member resigns.

Pledges are occasionally requested by Lions International. Once a member makes a pledge to any given cause, they are responsible to pay that pledge in full, regardless of their future status as a member. Resigning from the club does not exclude one from having to pay their pledge in full.

All Wheaton Lion members are expected to attempt to join us weekly for lunch, and to participate in at least one Lion Club committee. Committees include Program, Golf Outing, Membership, Candy Day, Benevolence, Publicity, Fund Raising, Special Projects, Scholarship and Eye Glasses. See attached sign-up sheet for more information and to sign up for a committee or two. New members are also asked to help with lunch service each week. This includes helping put the food out on the tables before each meal and helping clear the dishes when the meal is over.
